

**DUCHOUQUET TOWNSHIP
REGULAR MEETING**

APRIL 2, 2015

The Board of Duchouquet Township Trustees met in regular session on this 2nd day of April 2015 at 9:00 A.M. at the Township Meeting Room located at 16038 Dixie Highway, Wapakoneta, Ohio, Auglaize County.

The March 3th minutes and financial reports were given by the Fiscal Officer. Dwight Steinke made a motion to accept the reports as given. Bruce Rohrbacher seconded the motion; motion carried.

Tom Doorley reported to the Board:

1. He had 3 permits.
2. Fred Koenig sent out junk car letter at 14126 Schaub Rd.
3. Dustin Butler, Cemetery, got permit for shed, but no action on trucks.
4. Gordy Kill purchased property on National and 501 and plans to put up three barns to board race horses, plans on about 300 head.

The Fiscal Officer asks the Board if there were any problems with any liquor permits that will be coming up for renewal. The Board had none.

Justin Chishoem was present to discuss with the trustee the possibility on the Sherriff Department shooting

on the park area we have. There was no discussion made at this time, just wanting to review with the Board.

The Fiscal Officer reviewed with the Board the Audit results. Everything was good, but we will have to make a fund adjustment of \$21,615 from the General fund back to the Gas Tax fund. The health insurance reimbursement was taken out of the Gas Tax and must come out of the General due to all Salary was taken out of the General. Processing this adjustment will put the General Fund in a negative balance. Fiscal Officer is working with the State to get this situation resolved.

Bruce Rohrbacher made a motion for the township to make their own reflector strips to install on stop signs. We can purchase the material for about \$1,600 and to order from the County will be about \$2,970. Dwight Steinke seconded the motion; motion carried.

The Board discussed the projected road work for this year.

1. East Lake - concrete entrance way approximately \$15,000
2. Seitz Road, service road, full chip and seal and fog over and re-strip, 18 foot road, approximately \$18,000.
3. Mudsock Road, 1 mile of full chip seal and fog, approximately \$18,000

Bruce Rohrbacher made a motion to do the above listed work. Dwight Steinke seconded the motion, motion carried.

The Board decided not to do any road side spraying this year with the County.

Having no further business, Dwight Steinke made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Bruce Rohrbacher seconded the motion; motion carried.
