

**DUCHOUQUET TOWNSHIP  
REGULAR MEETING  
SEPTEMBER 1, 2015**

The Board of Duchouquet Township Trustees met in regular session on this 1<sup>st</sup> day of September 2015 at 8:00 P.M. at the Township Meeting Room located at 16038 N. Dixie 25A, Wapakoneta, Ohio, Auglaize County.

Bruce Rohrbacher made a motion to accept the minutes of August 4<sup>th</sup> regular meeting and the financial reports as given by the Fiscal Office. Dwight Steinke seconded the motion; motion carried.

Bruce Rohrbacher made a resolution to adopt the zoning amendment presented to the Board of Trustees by the Duchouquet Zoning Commission on August 4th from the Duchouquet Township Zoning Commission whereas they adopted the amendment proposed by Triskele LLC, c/o Rulon Smith, 1365 Shoreview Lane, Lima, OH 45805 to amend and revise the Duchouquet Township Zoning Resolution by redistricting 32.543 acres of ground from the Agricultural Zoning District (A-1) to General Commercial District (C-1) and further request that Section 902 of the Zoning Resolution be amended to add "Shooting Sports" to Conditionally Permitted Uses and by providing a definition for "Shooting Sports", all as set forth in the attached "Exhibit A". Bruce Rohrbacher moved the adoption of the following resolution: RESOLVED, By the Board in accordance with the provisions of law has previously adopted a Tax Budget for the next succeeding fiscal year commencing Jan 1, 2016 and WHEREAS, The Budget Commission of Auglaize County has certified its action thereon to this Board together with an estimate by the County Auditor of the rate of each tax necessary to be levied by this Board, and what part thereof is without, and what part within, the ten mill limitation; therefore, be it RESOLVED, By the Board that the amounts and rates as determined by the Budget Commission in its certification, be and the same are hereby accepted; and be it further RESOLVED, That there be and is hereby levied on the tax duplicate of said Township the rate of each tax necessary to be levied within and without the ten mill limitation as follows: General Inside 2.00 mill will generate \$48,185 Road & Bridge 2.75 inside mill will generate \$202,576 and Fire District 2.00 mill outside will generate \$120,506 and be it further RESOLVED, that the Fiscal Officer of this Board be and she is hereby directed to certify a copy of this resolution to the County Auditor of Said County.
