

**DUCHOUQUET TOWNSHIP
REGULAR MEETING**

APRIL 5, 2016

The Board of Duchouquet Township Trustees met in regular session on this 5th day of April 2016 at 7:00 P.M. at the Township Meeting Room located at 16038 Dixie Highway, Wapakoneta, Ohio, Auglaize County.

The meeting was called to order by President, John Limbert. Roll call was:

The March 8th minutes and financial reports were given by the Fiscal Officer. Dwight Steinke made a motion to accept the reports as given. Bruce Rohrbacher seconded the motion; motion carried.

Tom Doorley reported to the Board:

1 He had 5 permits to turn in. Rulan Smith, from Triskele LLC, gun facility in Cridersville is having trouble with survey and waiting to get that worked out to begin construction. City of Cridersville has contacted him about the sewer and water that they can provide if Rulan pays for it to go under I75. Rulan had questions about annexation and he would feel bad if it comes to annexation, since we helped him get the property ready for his business.

2 Tom also gave the Fiscal Officer the annual report filed for 2015 with the Enterprise Zone.

The Fiscal Officer asks the Board if there were any problems with any liquor permits that will be coming up for renewal. The Board had none.

Olivia Kentner with WHS GateKeepers, a Depression & Suicide Awareness Club at Wapakoneta High School, was present to inform the Board of the 5K run and walk event scheduled for May 14th at 9:15pm. Group will run from the Football Field and going thru township roads in Oak Wood Hills. The Board gave their permission and informed Olivia that she just needed to let them know if they needed to do anything to help out that day. The Board informed the Sheriff Deputy also tonight of the event.

Bruce Rohrbacher made a motion to nominate Chief Doug Ayers, Fire Chief City of St. Marys to fill the position of executive committee member on the Auglaize County Emergency Management Cooperative Board. Dwight Steinke seconded the motion. Roll call vote was all yes.

The Board discussed the projected road work for this year. Hengstler Road 1½ miles from 25A to Townline. (The actual total length is 2.67 miles)

The Board had got a quote from Stawser Construction of \$106,632.50 for micro surfacing.

County Engineer, Doug Reinhart informed the Board that he will put together a quote sheet for the slurry seal and get back with them. His estimate for Hengstler road was \$50,836.

Bruce Rohrbacher made a motion to table the discussion for the quote from Strawser Construction and wait for the quote from the County. Dwight Steinke seconded the motion, motion carried.

As prior resolution on 2-2-16 we also plan to do work in Oakwood Hills approximately 3 miles.

The Board decided not to do any road side

spraying this year with the County.

The Fiscal Officer reminded the Board of the County Engineer Department meeting and hog roast on April 14th.

Having no further business, Bruce Rohrbacher made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Dwight Steinke seconded the motion; motion carried.
