REGULAR MEETING

The Board of Duchouquet Township Trustees met in regular session on this 3rd day of October 2017 at 8:00 P.M. at the Township Meeting Room located at 16038 N. Dixie 25A, Wapakoneta, OH, Auglaize County.

The Fiscal Officer gave the Minutes and financial reports from the September 12. Dwight Steinke made a motion to accept the reports as given. Bruce Rohrbacher seconded the motion; motion carried.

Dave Howe reviewed with the Board his concerns of a big sinkhole and two big catch basins on his property on Glynwood Road. Bruce informed Dave that he has looked over the situation and has asked the City of Wapak to bring out their camera and plan to get this fixed for him. Dave thanked the Board and excused himself.

Tom Doorley, Zoning Inspector, had one permits this month. Tom informed the Board of junk cars behind house on Infirmity Road, demo junk cars on 25A, Bowersock continuous garage sale on ST. RT. 67, and Eugene Brown on Brown Road wanting to build multi family unit for parents.

Dwight Steinke reported to the MARCS radio meeting he attended. This is a nationwide radio system for the use in a disaster situation. Dwight informed the Sheriff that the township would take a returned radio, which will cost the township \$200 yearly for registration.

Bruce Rohrbacher reported to the Board on an estimate from American Pavements, Inc. to crack seal, ODOT 123 Crack Seal, Hot Applied, Type II, on five roads in the Township.

Roads include Linzee, Wapak Buckland, Reichelderfer, DeLong, and Freymuth at a total cost of \$40,850.00. Attached is the breakdown of each road. Dwight Steinke made a resolution to have this work done and Bruce Rohrbacher seconded the motion. Roll call was,
