The minutes of the Special End-of-the Year Meeting, Special Re-organizational and Special Annual Appropriations Meeting minutes were read. Dwight Steinke made a motion to approve the minutes as given. Rick Place seconded the motion; motion carried.

The Board will schedule the fire departments to meet with them at the March 6 meeting to set up and sign the fire contracts for next year.

Dwight Steinke made a motion to elect Rick Place to be township's delegate for the Auglaize County Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Management. Bruce Rohrbacher seconded the motion.


Having no further business, Dwight Steinke made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Rick Place seconded the motion; motion carried.
